Traveling through Vienna one summer, Oakland, California-based designer Annie Kantor came upon an exhibit of Wiener Werkstätte book covers—and thus was born a new panel collection. Josef Hoffmann's geometric motifs in particular inspired the three designs: **Stempel**, which repeats elongated triangles; **Stilkunst**, which sets ovals and squares within vertical bars; and **Bildmarke**, a tribute to the W logo Hoffmann often used on textiles. Kantor devised each pattern in Pointcarre Textile Software, later translating the designs into vector files that synch with laser-cutting machines. Panels of 16-gauge steel vary in size from 18 by 22 inches to 4 by 8 feet and can be powder-coated or specified in oil-rubbed bronze or in brushed or polished stainless steel, aluminum, or brass. ajkdesignsstudio.com ➤
